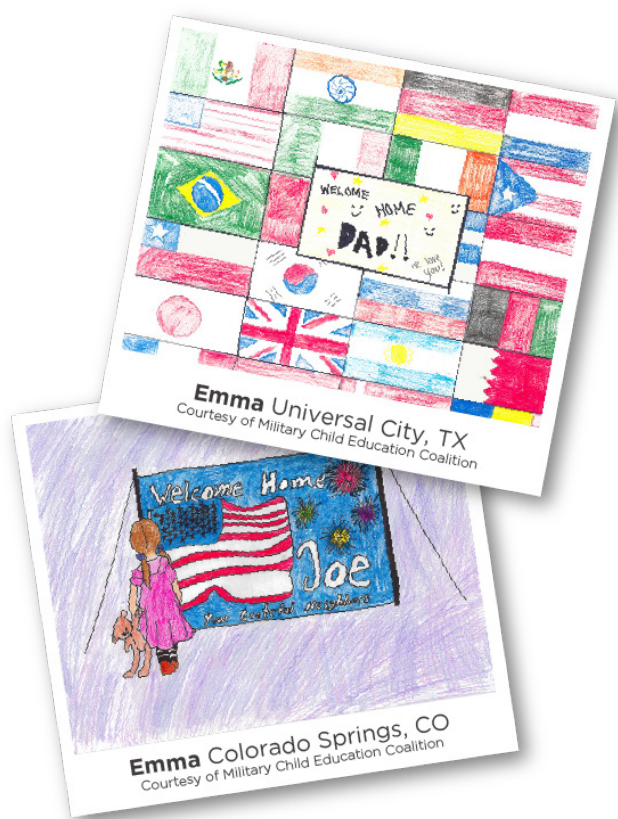


# The Biden Foundation wants to know: How do you picture home?
